Checking for PH-ILD: Separating Fact from Fiction

It's important to know the facts about checking for PH-ILD*, however, there are several myths and misconceptions that surround this process.

MYTH

PH only develops in later stage ILD.

FACT

PH can develop at the onset of your ILD, or any time after. That is why it is important to check regularly to catch PH early.

MYTH

Once you've been checked for PH and it's been ruled out, you can't develop PH later.

FACT

PH may appear at any time, so checking for PH once is not enough. Checking for PH needs to be done at every visit if possible.

MYTH

Early symptoms of PH are different than symptoms of ILD.

FACT

The symptoms are often similar. That's why the early symptoms of PH are often mistaken for symptoms of ILD.

*PH-ILD = pulmonary hypertension associated with interstitial lung disease
